### **Poster Presentation Guidelines**

ICOI Asia Pacific Congress 2025 • EXCO, Daegu, Korea • June 27-29, 2025

1. The Scientific Committee will consider the following categories for

Poster Presentations:

- · Basic science and/or clinical research
- · Clinical applications, techniques or tips
- · Laboratory applications, techniques or tips
- 2. A maximum of two presenters will be permitted for any one Poster Presentation
- 3. All applications will be reviewed by the Scientific Program Committee and will be selected based on merit and appropriateness of subject.
- 4. The objective of the Poster Presentation is a concise display of a single concept/technique lasting a maximum of 10 minutes so that multiple presentations can be made to small groups. Presenters must also have a 3 minute summation to give to the judges upon request.
- 5. Poster Presentations should be laminated and of professional quality. The poster must be exactly 841 mm wide x 1,189 mm high. The following will be provided by the ICOI for Poster Presentations:
  - A panel (950 mm wide x 2,380 mm high) to display your poster.
  - The poster must be exactly 841 mm wide x 1,189 mm high.
     Please see the sample provided on the last page.
  - · Sign with assigned Poster No./Table top No. for each individual.
- 6. Commercial affiliations, with or without financial support, must be disclosed on the Poster Presentations Applications. The ICOI discourages the use of commercial names in presentations.
- 7. ICOI AP 2025 Scientific committee will judge all presentations. The first place winner of the competition will receive 500 USD. The second place winner will receive 250 USD, the third place winner will receive 150 USD. All winners will be announced during the meeting.
- 8. Poster Presentations will be held on all the time during the ICOI AP Congress, June 27-29. Posters need to be mounted by 10:00 on June 28, 2025. Posters are to remain on display for the duration of the meeting and should be removed on Sunday, June 29, 2025 during the afternoon break.
- 9. The ICOI is unable to waive registration fees or provide travel/lodging expenses for the poster presenters. **You must register for the event**. 
